
TOGAF Certification for People

- Is a common baseline of knowledge
- Provides a visible trust mark
- Is a foundation for the emerging profession

Level	Tag	Purpose
1	TOGAF 9 Foundation	To provide validation that the candidate has gained knowledge of the terminology and basic concepts of TOGAF 9 and understands the core principles of Enterprise Architecture and TOGAF
2	TOGAF 9 Certified	To provide validation that in addition to knowledge and comprehension, the candidate is able to analyze and apply knowledge of TOGAF



Level 1 – TOGAF 9 Foundation Target Audience

- Individuals requiring a basic understanding of TOGAF 9
- Professionals working in roles associated with an architecture project such as those responsible for planning, execution, development, delivery and operation
- Architects looking for a first introduction to TOGAF 9
- Architects who want to achieve Level 2 certification in a stepwise approach.




- Individuals requiring a deeper understanding of TOGAF 9;

- Architects who want to achieve a recognized qualification to demonstrate their detailed knowledge of TOGAF 9.






